On behalf of Dalhan Parivar and Organizing Committee, we are extending invitation to all the Plant Pathologists (Researchers, Teachers, Scholars and Students) to participate actively in the National Symposium and make it a grand success.

About the venue

Kanpur is one of the major cities of Uttar Pradesh and is also famous for leather items and education. Kanpur is well connected with roads and rails. The nearest airport is Lucknow, which is 80 km from Kanpur. One can take taxi or train to reach Kanpur. IIPR is located on GT Road at No. 12 railway crossing.

About the symposium

Abstract Submission

Abstracts are invited on all the aspects of the themes of the symposium or related to the management of plant diseases using eco-friendly methods. The abstract should contain a title, names of authors, their affiliation and summary of results (250 to 300 words) and reach the organizing secretary (Emails: ipsmezkanpur/kkpath@gmail.com) latest by 15 December 2016.

Presentation

The symposium will be having one or two key note speakers for each session. Some of the selected papers will be allowed as oral presentation and the rest will be presented in the poster session under each theme. Please mention the type of presentation (oral/poster) you want while submitting the abstract and registration form.

Preparation of posters

The poster size should not exceed 30" (width) x 40" (length). The poster should have title, authors, address, introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion. The font's size should not be less than 22. It is advised to use commonly used fonts like Times New Roman or Arial. Best poster presentation will be awarded with a certificate.
